

Agile Project Management Foundation module and exam



Overview

The Agile Project Management™ (AgilePM®) approach aims to address the needs of those working in a project-focused environment who want to be agile. It enables Project Managers to adopt a mature, scalable agile approach that can work with business project initiatives. It works alongside more formal project management approaches such as PRINCE2®.

Agile has been used for many years to deliver IT projects. However, the principles can be used for non IT projects that can be broken down into stages that can be worked on iteratively to create and validate an evolving solution.

The AgilePM® accreditations were launched in 2011 by APMG and the DSDM Consortium to address the need to run projects in an agile way. Agile project management provides numerous benefits to organisations, such as better product quality, higher customer satisfaction, improved performance visibility, and increased project control.

The AgilePM® has two levels of accreditation;

- i. Foundation level covers the core terminology and principles.
- ii. Practitioner level demonstrates an understanding of how to apply the terminology and principles in a project scenario.

Who is it for?

Any organisation that wants to adopt a common approach for agile projects, that can be integrated with a business project management approach, such as PRINCE2.

- Practising project managers.
- Agile team members looking to become Agile Project Managers .
- Individuals that want to gain a recognised AgilePM accreditation.
- Organisations wanting to establish a common approach to implementing Agile

Online AgilePM® Foundation Exam Preparation Course – 12 month licence

The Foundation-level qualification aims to measure whether the candidate has sufficient knowledge and understanding of the Agile Project Management Foundation guidance to be able to recognise and distinguish between the key elements of the approach. The Foundation qualification is also a pre-requisite for the Practitioner qualification.

Foundation Exam

The exam can be taken online or paper based at the exam location.

- Multiple choice format
- 50 questions per paper
- 25 marks required to pass (out of 50 available) - 50%
- 40 minutes duration
- Closed book.
